4.1. <u>Description of first aid measures:</u>	In case of health problems due to excessive exposure to product dust;
4.1.1. If excessive amounts of the product are inhaled:	Move the affected person to the fresh air, wash the face properly with water, rinse the mouth (or nose) with clear water, rest, do not smoke, if respiratory problems occur then seek medical assistance.

- 6.1. Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures: Minimize dust! Use personal protective means, follow the instructions of chapters 7 and 8, do not inhale the dust, avoid excessive contact with skin and eyes.
Avoid further dust distribution, for example by wetting the material.
- 6.2. Environmental precautions: Prevent wind dispersal of the loose fibrous dust.
